

Cork Strip Bowls

Handy little bowls
Made from zigzag stitched cork
fabric strips
Optional covers make them
stackable!



MATERIALS

FABRIC

CORK FABRIC for BOWL SIDES One 18" x 27" rectangle

OR 10 strips 2½" x 18" from leftover cork fabric

Makes one large 8" wide x 4¼" tall OR two small 6" wide x 2¾" tall bowls

COORDINATING FABRIC ½ yard

Use for binding and bottom

INTERFACING

½ yard

20" wide stiff double-sided fusible interfacing like Bosal's Craf-Tex Plus
or Pellon's 72F for the bowl bottoms

MATCHING COTTON THREAD

We recommend So Fine by Superior Threads for zigzag stitching and 12
weight thread for hand sewing

ADDITIONAL FOR OPTIONAL COVER

CORK FABRIC 2½" x 18" strips for Rim (3 for Lrge or 4 for Small)
1 Square for Top (9" for Lrge or 7" for Small)

COORDINATING FABRIC ½ yard

INTERFACING ½ yard

Other Tools: Sewing Machine with a good zigzag stitch and a free arm.
Machine needles - Janome's Purple Tip needles (for zigzag stitching).
Scissors (both large and small), rotary mat, 60mm rotary cutter,
acrylic rulers, pins, seam ripper, measuring tape. Steam iron. Teflon
sheet or parchment paper. Removable chalk or Frixion pen. Circle drawing tool - try Creative
Grids Quick Trim Ruler 3½" x 12½" Rectangle
CGRMT1.

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
