



# PRETTY POTS

Liven up your potted plants, dried or artificial flowers by putting them in a really Pretty Pot! Have fun with Paverpol, a fabric stiffener, and just a few strips of fabric.

## Materials

**FABRIC** Chose a favorite fabric or use up scraps.

Note: fabric will looker darker (almost as if it were wet) after applying fabric stiffener. Pretty Pot size  $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ .

Pot Body: Cut 9 strips  $2\frac{1}{2}''$  wide x  $42/44''$  or WOF  
(Cut additional strips for a larger Pretty Pot)  
Binding: Cut 1 strip  $4'' \times 42/44''$  or WOF

**BATTING** Use a medium weight batting  $45''$  wide  
(try Quilter's Dream - Select or Deluxe)

Pot Body: Cut 9 strips  $2\frac{1}{2}''$  wide x  $45''$   
Binding: Cut 1 strip  $2'' \times 45''$

**MATCHING COTTON THREAD** use a 50 weight 2 ply thread

**PAVERPOL** A transparent fabric stiffener

Paverpol is a non-toxic fabric stiffener with the same consistency as white glue. If you cannot find it at your local quilt shop, order it online at [paverpolusa.com](http://paverpolusa.com). One 250 ml squeeze bottle will do at least one pot. Larger tubs will do more. Make sure to purchase transparent Paverpol. Note: Keep Paverpol at room temperature. Do not allow to freeze.

**DREAM SEAM** Batting seam tape (optional)

Other Tools: Sewing machine with a good zigzag stitch, machine needles both Microtex 90/14 (for straight stitching) and Jean's or Denim 110/18 (for zigzag stitching). Several 2" sponge brushes. Cardboard paper towel tube cut in half. Scissors (both large and small), rotary mat, rotary cutter, acrylic rulers, chalk, seam ripper, measuring tape.

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
